

### 3 Sustainable Bright Health and Safety Policy Statement

The activities undertaken by Sustainable Bright as a Company are covered by the provisions of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and its Statutory Provisions (notably the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999, Construction, Design and Management Regulations 2015) which requires health and safety to be managed effectively.

Sustainable Bright as a Company recognises the importance of Health & Safety as an integral part of their business and is keen to integrate their Operational Principals by operating with honesty and integrity whilst caring for the people they work with. - To provide such information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary, so far as is reasonably practicable to ensure the health and safety at work of all employees.
- To achieve the effective co-operation and involvement from employees in attaining our Health and Safety Operational Principals by maintaining a methodology of continuous improvement within all aspects of the business, at all levels.
- To ensure our management lead by example and in doing so communicate and encourage all our employees/sub-contractors to adopt health and safety as proactive management methodology.

This policy will be maintained as a high-profile document and will be subject to a biannual review or where major changes to our business operations or changes to the legislation affect its integrity.
